- * Does Memorandum of Understanding with the Ontario Provincial Police still exist, 86
- * Given that it is over a month since an update was provided, can minister provide an update on the investigation into the death of Donald Dunphy, 1008
- * Given that Premier's Chief of Staff was the former Chief of the Royal Newfoundland Constabulary, is Premier aware that the Memorandum of Understanding exists, 87
- * Given the conclusions of the Luther inquiry and the Lamer inquiry, why does Premier not support the call for an outside police force to conduct the investigation, 86
- * Given the minister's authority, has he even talked to the head of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, 141
- * Has minister made inquiries for an update to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, the Royal Newfoundland Constabulary, or the Chief Medical Examiner, 1008
- * Has minister talked to the head of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police about this matter, 141
- * Is Minister certain that he doesn't have the authority to intervene, 85
- * Is minister saying that the two days prior to the shooting are not part of the investigation, 139
- * Is there a Memorandum of Understanding among the Royal Newfoundland Constabulary, the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, and the Ontario Provincial Police, and will the minister table it, 138
- * Why do minister and Premier continue to refuse to do what is appropriate and recognized by multiple judges in this country, and give this investigation independent, outside oversight, 143
- * Why does Premier still resist having an outside police force conduct the investigation, 87

- * Why has minister not used his authority and spoken to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police on this matter, 142
- * Why have neither the minister nor the Premier spoken to the head of police about this very serious matter, 142
- * Why will minister not call in an outside police force, as he has the authority to do, 85
- * Will minister clarify whether both forces are involved in investigating, and which parts each force is investigating, 139-140
- * Will minister confirm that the two days prior to the time that the tweet was sent to the Premier's office will be included in the investigation, 139
- * Will minister table the engagement letter with Justice Riche, 141
- * Will minister table the Memorandum of Understanding among the Royal Newfoundland Constabulary, the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, and the Ontario Provincial Police, 139
- * Will Premier now support the call for an outside police force to complete the investigation, 85

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
