Cpl. Burke:

Hi Steve,

Cpl. Knapman has commenced his review of this incident and has identified additional material he would like to have.

He noted that Cst Smyth never states **why** he fired two rounds to the body then two rounds to the head. Furthermore investigators did not explore this avenue. Cpl. Knapman feels this is a crucial factor given the totality of the situation. Could the investigators go back to Cst Smyth and ask for clarification on what his thought process/reason why he fired two rounds to the body and two to the head. It is important for Cpl. Knapman to have Cst Smyth's articulation on this point.

Second, Cpl. Knapman requests a copy of the RNC's course of fire for their pistol qualification.

Third, Cpl. Knapman does not have copies of the statements of Richard Dunphy and Debbie Dunphy who spoke with the member prior to him attending the residence. These statements may provide insight towards the member's risk assessment. Also, is there a statement for Donna Ivy, who works for the Premiere's office and who advised the member of the tweets?

Finally, is there an update on the arrival of the ballistics report?
