Dear A/S/Sgt Jeannotte and Sgt Patrick Lenehan:

Further to our telephone discussion, thank you so much for agreeing to do this on such short notice. As discussed we need a report asap. The Inquiry ends around 8 March and we have to apply to have this evidence introduced before then.

Attached is an outline of the facts for you to base your opinion on and there will be a number of emails following with exhibits attached and other (hopefully) useful information.

All correspondence between us will have to be provided to the Commission inquiring into the death of Donald Dunphy.

The next email, email 2, will contain an undertaking which every person who works on this will have to sign.

We are requesting that you review the materials provided and render an impartial, objective opinion regarding Cst Joe Smyth's threat and risk assessment with respect to Donald Dunphy.

The issues that have arisen during the hearings that you may wish to keep in mind or comment on are as follows:

1. Did the tweet of concern warrant a threat and risk assessment?
2. What is a threat and risk assessment?
3. Should Smyth have gathered more information before visiting Dunphy?
4. Why did he not just call him on the phone and speak to him?
5. Did he have to go and visit him on Easter Sunday and why did he not wait?
6. Why did he not simply monitor Dunphy's tweets for a while to see what came up?
7. Should he have gone alone?
